- 2. Critically analyse the concept of 'dislocation and displacement' addressed in Naipaul's A Bend in the River.
- 3. 'We see what we want to see'. Examine Cortazar's interpretation of individual perception in "The Blow Out".
- 4. Discuss how Kishwar Naheed's poem "The Grass is Really like me" constructs resistance to suppression from a male-dominated society .
- 5. 'And now here is my secret, a very simple secret: It is only with the heart that one can see rightly; what is essential is invisible to the eye'. Discuss with reference to *The Little Prince*.
- 6. 'The Mystic Drum' and "Bora Ring" address the impact of European settlement on Native and Aboriginal cultures. Discuss.



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
